

PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS



PERMIT DISPLAY

Parking permits MUST be properly displayed while parked:

- Automobiles. Hang permit from interior rearview mirror, facing forward. Permit must be clearly visible. If windshield tint strip prevents clear display, permit hangers are available from NIC Parking Management.
- Motorcycles. Permit must be clearly visible from the front or rear of the motorcycle.
- Exceptions must be approved by NIC Parking Management in advance.

PARKING SPACES

- All parts of the vehicle MUST be inside the designated parking space; generally indicated by two white lines. Parking in grassy areas is not permitted unless at the direction of special event parking staff.
- **Motorcycles** will require the purchase of the same permit as an automobile. **If automobile permit is clearly displayed on the motorcycle, parking is authorized in automobile spaces in the lot designated by lot color and letter on the permit.** Permit holders are responsible for any lost or stolen permits displayed on motorcycles. Locking permit holders are available for purchase from NIC Parking Management for \$25 each.
- Any vehicle not parked in a designated legal space is subject to ticketing and/or towing at the owner's expense.
- Any vehicle parked along curbs, on sidewalks, hindering/damaging NIC operations or property, or obstructing roadways, designated handicap spaces, wheelchair ramp laydown (hashed out) areas, and reserved spaces is subject to ticketing and/or towing at the owner's expense.
- Parking is not permitted in Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) spaces without a state-issued handicap placard and a NIC parking permit for the designated lot. The ramp laydown (hashed out) area adjacent to the space is considered part of the space and will be enforced accordingly.
- Reserved spaces are reserved 24 hours a day, 7 days a week unless otherwise noted on the sign. This includes holidays.

LOADING AND UNLOADING

Vehicles with current NIC parking permits or UNL faculty/staff permits may park in a designated loading zone space for a maximum of 15 minutes for the purpose of loading/unloading supplies or equipment. Flashers must be operating.

DISABLED VEHICLES

- If a vehicle is disabled, the permit holder must notify NIC Parking Management at 402-434-9440 IMMEDIATELY, with their name, the vehicle's license plate number, and location.
- A grace period of up to 12 hours may be allowed. **No Extensions!**
- This grace period does not automatically exempt your vehicle from being ticketed; however, it may be used as a basis for appeal.
- **Notes left on a vehicle** stating that the vehicle is mechanically disabled are given no consideration by enforcement personnel. Vehicles not properly reported to NIC Management may be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense.

ALL PARKING LOTS ARE PRIVATE

Any vehicle on the NIC campus is parked at the owner's risk. Neither the lot owner nor the University assumes liability for vehicles parked on Nebraska Innovation Campus property.

- Parking on NIC is authorized by NIC Parking Management and governed by these rules and regulations. Questions regarding parking permits should be referred to NIC Parking Management.
- In order to park in designated lots on the NIC campus, all UNL employees/faculty/staff primarily assigned to the NIC are required to purchase NIC permits.
- Parking is authorized ONLY in lots identified by color and lot designation of the assigned parking permit.
- NIC Parking Management does not issue permits to UNL students. Students must purchase through UNL Parking Services.

VISITOR PARKING

Recreational vehicle parking is NOT permitted on the NIC campus. NOTE: UNL and NIC campus students and employees are not considered visitors to campus and are prohibited from using the designated visitor parking spaces.

- **Invited visitors** to the NIC campus are required to park in the designated visitor areas noted on the NIC Parking Map.
- **Guaranteed Visitor Parking Permits** are available for purchase from NIC Parking Management at the rate of \$5 per day, in the Red "A" North Lot Only
- **Overnight parking** is prohibited in all designated visitor areas.
